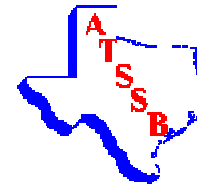

Mr. Dean Bouras

Dean Bouras is in his 27th year as a Texas music educator, and in his 26th year as Director of Bands for the Royse City ISD.

Bouras is also a freelance Jazz guitarist and arranger in the Dallas/ Ft. Worth Metroplex . He has appeared with numerous ensembles including the Les Elgart Orchestra, Dallas Jazz Orchestra, University of North Texas Jazz Guitar Ensemble, and the Dallas Wind Symphony. His arrangements have been performed and recorded by many high school, college and professional bands and orchestras. Bouras arranges and records the jazz guitar arrangements for the ATSSB All State Jazz audition etudes, and is currently a staff arranger for the Dallas Wind Symphony.

Bouras received the 1979 Sibelius Memorial Scholarship, for post graduate studies in composition and conducting at the Sibelius Academy of Music in Helsinki, Finland.

Bouras holds professional memberships in the Texas Music Educators Association, Texas Bandmasters Association, and BMI. He holds a Bachelors of Arts Degree in Music Education from St Louis University, and a Masters of Music Degree In Jazz Education from the University of North Texas.
