Minutes of the Regular Meeting

The Board of Trustees Commerce ISD

A regular meeting of the Board of Trustees of the Commerce Independent School District was held on April 18, 2017, at 6:00 p.m. at the Commerce ISD Administration Building, 3315 Washington St., Commerce, Texas. President Kathleen Hooten called the meeting to order, extended a warm welcome and announced that a quorum was present. The meeting had been posted for the time and manner required by law.

Board members present were Mrs. Hooten, Mr. Michael Beane, Ms. Etta Herring, Dr. Mark Reid, Mr. Randy Starks and Mr. Gabe Wittkopf. Dr. LaVelle Hendricks was absent.

Executive Session...

Mrs. Hooten announced that the Board would convene in executive session at 6:07 p.m. to consider personnel (§551.074) and private consultation with Board's attorney, if needed (§551.071).

Reconvene from Executive Session...

Mrs. Hooten announced that the Board ended its closed session 7:07 p.m. on April 18, 2017.

Opening Activities

Mr. Starks led an invocation. The pledge to the U.S. flag was led by Mr. Wittkopf and the pledge to the Texas flag was led by Ms. Herring.

Recognition

The Board recognized regional and state powerlifter qualifier Brayden Lopez, regional powerlifting qualifier Tahae Henry, Varsity Boys Basketball Co-District Champions, Claire Dobbs, Academic All-State Girls Basketball Team; Claire Dobbs and Kassady Todhunter, All-State Cheerleading and Academic All-State Cheerleading. Lopez and Henry were unable to attend.

Texas State Solo & Ensemble Qualifiers included Grace Tolly, Joseph Jang and Caitlin Sneed. Jang did not attend.

Lisa Young was recognized as the Commerce Elementary School Teacher of the Year.

Action on Items Discussed in Executive Session

Mr. Wittkopf made a motion to accept the resignations of Eddie Barker, Jeff Cleveland, Judy Evans, Brian Lewis and Travis Smith, CHS teachers; Amber Sanders, Stefanie Spinks and Paul Turner, CMS; Patricia Hawkins, ACW; and Weston Evans, CES. Mr. Starks seconded the motion. The motion carried unanimously.

Mr. Wittkopf made a motion to approve a fourth year probationary contract for James Mills and extend contracts for teachers, counselors, school nurse and athletic trainer as presented (see attached). Mr. Starks seconded the motion. The motion carried unanimously.

Mr. Wittkopf made a motion to accept the resignation of Kacie Crowson, Tri County speech language pathologist. Ms. Herring seconded the motion. The motion carried unanimously.

Mr. Wittkopf made a motion to extend contracts of Tri County SSA Personnel as presented (see attached). Mr. Starks seconded the motion. Dr. Reid abstained and all others voted for the contract extensions.

Citizens' Comments

None.

Consent Agenda

Mr. Wittkopf made a motion to approve the minutes of the regular meeting on March 23, 2017 and the financial statements and investment summary for March 2017. Dr. Reid seconded the motion. The motion carried unanimously.

Consider Renewal Agreement with Chartwells

Director of Finance John Walker explained that this was the second renewal of the five-year agreement with Chartwells. Management fees were increasing .04/1 cent; however, participation was down. Mr. Starls made a motion to approve Chartwells renewal agreement as presented. Ms. Herring seconded the motion. The motion carried unanimously.

Discuss 2016-2017 Budget as it Relates to Enrollment

Mr. Walker explained that because of a 63 student drop in enrollment from this time last year, this year's budget was \$226,000 in the red. He said that funds for several items were not expended so that could help make up the deficit.

Appoint Board Member to Serve on Teacher of the Year Selection Committee Mr. Starks made a motion to name Kathleen Hooten to the Teacher of the Year selection committee. Ms. Herring seconded the motion. The motion carried unanimously.

Presentation of Results of Elementary Curriculum Audit

Dr. Tremmel explained that Robyn Hartzell was contracted to conduct and elementary curriculum audit at CES and ACW. Ms. Harzell offered ideas for improvement that would be included in the professional development plan.

CES Principal Diane Stegall and ACW Principal Lisa Palazzetti explained their plan of action based on the findings of the audit. CES will focus on writing program, testing/assessments, anchor charts and prime time. ACW priorities will be reading and writing.

Presentation of 2017-2018 #cisdPR1DE Professional Development Plan

Assistant Superintendent Dr. Patricia Tremmel introduce Cari Sturch, elementary curriculum coordinator, who explained the new professional plan and catalog that teachers could use to plan their PD with principal's approval. She said that a badge accomplishment system was being used as a visible reminder of trainings completed. Heather Kilgore, instructional technology coordinator, explained how an online book story would also enhance teachers' thought process.

Mrs. Hooten said that the collaboration was impressive and that she appreciated the time and efforts of the iCAT team to develop the program.

Discuss Professional Development Stipend

Mr. Alderman said that the Distinguished Professional Development Plan that awarded cash incentives for PD completion, was being discontinued for the 17-18 school year and, if funds allowed, additional money could be awarded to employees at mid year.

Consider Approval of Waiver from TEC Code §21.35(a)(2) and 21.352 (a)(2)(B) as it Relates to Student Growth Within the Teacher Appraisal System

Dr. Tremmel explained that a waiver was necessary if the District wanted to delay having the student growth indicated included in the T-TESS teacher appraisal. Mr. Wittkopf made a motion to approve waiver as presented. Mr. Beane seconded the motion. The motion carried unanimously.
