## **New CHS flooring purchase approved**

The CISD Board of Trustees approved a \$180,000 bid from All Commercial Floors to replace the carpeting in all CHS offices and classrooms. The replaceable carpet tiles can be maintained more easily than tile flooring, CHS Principal Roger Brown stated in his presentation to the Board. All Commercial owner Mike White has provided and installed all of the flooring throughout the district. Funds for the flooring were distributed from the District's fund balance.

A new ag truck purchase was also approved. The previous ag truck was involved in an accident last spring. Ford Family Auto Commerce was awarded the bid because of their hometown support and local service.

## **OTHER ACTION...**

The Board approved the following:

- District Improvement Plan and Campus Improvement Plans,
- the use of Hart voting equipment for the November 2 bond election,
- accepting the donation of two shuttle buses from Texas A&M University-Commerce. The 32-passenger buses will be used to transport smaller groups of students and
- accepted the resignation of Nick Smith, CMS assistant principal.

Mr. Alderman reported a six-student drop in enrollment since last month with a total count of 1448.

Director of Finance John Walker provided the required annual review of investment policy and investment strategies.
